Overview of Program

Financial Services

Students who successfully complete the Financial Services program (three years) will be adequately prepared to understand personal business-economic issues, solve problems, and enter the labor market in financial institutions, including banking, insurance, and investments.

Students enrolled in the Financial Services Program will be members of the local, state, and national chapters of FBLA.

Students enrolled in the Financial Services Program will be responsible for maintaining and running a school store, with the students of Marketing.

Courses required to complete the program

Financial Strategies

Course Description: This course is designed to expose students to the skills and knowledge needed in financial careers and to teach personal financial management strategies, such as budgeting, etc.

Financial Services

Students will expand on the knowledge and skills gained in Financial Strategies and will assist the Marketing students in running a school store and/or school-based enterprise. Students will learn basic financial recordkeeping skills, participate in work-based learning experiences such as job shadowing, and spend time learning about various financial institutions such as banking, insurance, and securities.

CTE internship

Students will engage in learning through participation in a structured work experience that involves the application of previously developed CTE knowledge and skills.
